- RESPECT

 - Homework will be checked or collected for completion points at the beginning of each class period.
 - The most important part of homework is that you attempt it. If you did not understand a problem, the beginning of class will be used to review problems.
 - *From time to time,* I will choose 3-5 questions from the homework assignment to grade for accuracy.
